Subject: SACRTF recommendations to the selectmen.

Don,
At the last meeting on March 1, 2006 the SACRTF voted the following recommendations

Fee Increases In the Commuter Rail Parking Lot

The daily fee for parking at the meters shall be increased from \$2.00 to \$2.50

The annual fee for the resident parking sticker shall be increased from \$25.00 to \$50.00

Jones Field Parking

The Martin Street parking that is paved and not specifically marked for playground parking shall be lined and the spaces numbered.

The haphazard parking along Stow Street be defined with adequate lines and barriers to be parallel parking with the spaces being numbered.

Staff shall devise a plan to have commuters pay monthly a fee of \$50.00 for a reserved space. There shall be no parking in any of the numbered spaces from 6 to 9 am, Monday thru Friday except for those paying for a reserved space. Signage shall be posted and the application for the reserved space shall specify the walking route to the train station. The above program will be in place by May 15th. This program will be evaluated over the next several months and changes made as deemed appropriate.
