As discussed, as Chairman of the Cable Advisory Committee, I recommend the following with respect to the Verizon Licensing Process:

Based primarily, but not exclusively, on the unavailability of the Special Cable Council for Monday's hearing on Verizon's Application for a Cable License, I recommend that the hearing be opened and continued to a date certain in the same manner as the Sept. 11th hearing date. That date should be as soon as possible, and based on scheduling factors, I would suggest, Tuesday, Oct. 2nd.

I request that two members of the BOS work directly with members negotiating team to address any outstanding issues. This would include meeting with Verizon as early as Tuesday September 26th. Because of scheduling factors this meeting would have to end no later than 6pm.
