Bill - attached is the revised draft of the Acton - Verizon license. We have made the two changes that were discussed and agreed upon last week: the PEG Grant will be paid in three installments (instead of four) in years 1, 3 and 10 (instead of years 1, 3, 5 and 10) - see section 5.3; and changed the audit cap from \$15K (not \$10K) and once every 24 months (not 30 months). I have also attached a blackline which shows these changes to the previous draft.

This should be considered the final license for consideration at the Acton Board of Selectmen's hearing tomorrow night. I will bring four copies of this to the hearing (two originals for you/the Town; and two for me/Verizon). I trust that you will bring the side letter to the hearing for vote and signature by the Board.
