An update on the NESWC legislation. I appreciate people being available for a call this morning, but I think we should hold it until I hear back from Rep. Finegold's office. I spoke to her in the afternoon Friday and clarified her understanding of what was "coming out" of the drafted legislation (See attached). I believe, and she is now confirming with Ways and Means, that we will be able to leave in Section 6, which is the key provision for us in my opinion, because it does not "point to" the Commonwealth, but simply says NESWC has no future liabilities.

Once that is confirmed, I will get back in touch with everybody asap. If we can leave that in, then I think we move forward. The language to come out re: contracts and liabilities is less important because we have no more active contracts or payments due.

I received a call this morning from Jessica Prince in Rep. Finegold's office. House Ways and Means has told them that they will only forward the NESWC dissolution bill out of their committee if all of the language transferring liability to the Commonwealth is removed. Rep. Finegold reportedly agrees with this approach, though I have not yet connected with them since getting their message.

I don't know if we want to have a call on this, or discuss via email. I'm happy to set up a call and if so please let me know your availability for something today or Monday if possible.
