Subject: **Street Acceptances**

The Planning Board at its meeting on February 27, 2007 voted to recommend acceptance of the following streets as public ways:

1. Squirrel Hill Road in the Colonial Acres IV Subdivision from the current limits of the public way northeasterly for a distance of ± 1544 feet to Notre Dame Road and Arlington Street.
2. Marian Road in the Colonial Acres IV Subdivision from the current limits of the public way westerly for a distance of ± 277 feet to Squirrel Hill Road

There is work that the developer still needs to complete. The Planning Board is holding a cash bond that is sufficiently large to secure these items. The Board has sent the Developer notice that he must complete his work by August 1, 2007; otherwise it will draw the bond.
