PUBLIC HEARING ZONING AMENDMENT SITE PLAN/LID MANUAL

The Town of Littleton Planning Board will hold a Public Hearing on Thursday, April 26, 2007 at 8:30 p.m. in Room 103 of the Shattuck Street Town Hall to consider amending the Zoning Bylaw, Chapter 173-18 of the Code of the Town of Littleton regarding Site Plan requirements according to MGL Chapter 40A, Section 5.

The proposed amendment is to require use of Low Impact Design and Best Management Practices in drainage design. The complete text of the proposed zoning amendment is on file at Town Clerk and Planning Board offices and can be viewed during their office hours or online at www.Littletonma.org. See Warrant Article # 15.

Any person interested or wishing to be heard on the proposed zoning amendment should appear at the time and place designated.
