Dear Selectman,

We are writing you to inform you that your town can qualify for Clean Energy Choice® funding from the Massachusetts Technology Collaborative (MTC) to support the purchase of a 2kW photovoltaic (solar electric) installation.

Through Clean Energy Choice (www.cleanenergychoice.org), ratepayers that opt to pay a premium to support renewable energy* earn MTC matching grants for their town/city. MTC also provides bonus funds to cities/towns for a 2kW solar installation if a town achieved 150 new Clean Energy Choice participants by 4/30/08. Your town has met this goal. To take advantage of this Clean Energy Choice bonus and receive up to \$25,000 from MTC to cover

the cost of this installation, your town must agree to allow MTC to use \$9,000 of your city/town's Clean Energy Choice "regular" matching funds to help pay for the installation.

As of 4/30/08 Acton has \$8,030 in the Acton Clean Energy Choice account. If you agree to pledge this \$8,030 towards the cost of the 2kW PV array, and the next \$970 of matching funds Acton earns through this program over the next 12 months, you can opt in to receive the 2kW PV bonus array Acton has earned by getting over 150 households to participate.

MTC requests that you respond to this email with a confirmation that your town would like to opt into the Clean Energy Choice 2kW PV Bonus Program. Thank you and I look forward to hearing from you by Friday May 11, 2007.
