Hi Lauren, Dore', Catherine, and Manager's Dept.:

As you know, Community Preservation Committee (CPC) members stated at their last meeting that they are still interested in meeting with Marc Draisen of MAPC and Stuart Saginor of the Community Preservation Coalition. I mentioned this in an e-mail to Lauren at the end of last week and she said Marc Draisen also seemed interested in meeting with Acton and suggested I call him. When I called Marc, I got his voice mail, so I left a message. Justin Sellars from MAPC called me back for Marc today and also sent an e-mail (see below).

As discussed below, the proposed CPA Bill is scheduled for a hearing at the State House on June 11, 2007. The only meeting of the Board of Selectmen before that date is this Monday, June 4, 2007. The CPC's next meeting is not until June 14, 2007. Dore' (or Don), do you want to schedule Marc Draisen for the June 4th BOS meeting? Justin Sellars at MAPC is checking with Marc to see if he is available, just in case. If not, is there another day and time the Selectmen and/or CPC want to meet with Marc - either before or after June 11th? FYI - I have not contacted Stuart Saginor of the Community Preservation Coalition.

Please let me know how you want to proceed and I can contact Justin Sellars to let him know.
