

Vaccines

Acton Public Health Nursing Service participates in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Vaccine Program and obtains the following vaccines from the state program.

The following vaccines are available:

- Tetnus
- DTP-Diphtheria, Tetnus and Pertussis
- MMR-Measles, Mumps and Rubella
- Hepatitis A (adult & child)
- Hepatitis B (adult and child)
- Polio (IPV)
- Varicella-Chickenpox
- Pneumococcal Pnemonia
- Influenza
- HIB-Haemophilus Influenza Type B

A fee of \$10 is charged for the administration of the vaccine, but no one will be turned away for inability to pay. Our goal is to get all children the vaccines they need and for certain adult vaccines that qualify under the program.
