Dear Official:

Tennessee Gas Pipeline (TGP), a subsidiary of El Paso Corporation, is an interstate transporter of natural gas supplies headquartered in Houston, Texas. TGP would like to thank you for the important role that you play in maintaining the safety of our pipeline system.

As a leader in safety and compliance, TGP dedicates thousands of hours monthly to maintaining safe and reliable pipelines. Some of the safety measures we have established include using high-strength pipeline materials, implementing corrosion protection techniques, and performing routine testing and inspection. Our gas control office electronically monitors the pipeline system 24 hours a day.

We acknowledge the importance of emergency responders in maintaining a safe environment in the communities you serve. TGP works closely with emergency response personnel to develop response plans for fire, rupture, major leak, or other serious incidents at or near one of our facilities.

I would like to acquaint the emergency response organizations within your community with TGP's emergency response plans and at the same time learn the responsibility and resources your organizations retain. Reviewing these plans can help us to engage in mutual assistance to minimize the hazards to life and property in the unlikely event of a pipeline emergency.

Enclosed you will find TGP's Emergency Personnel List indicating whom to notify in case of an emergency. The list includes a twenty-four (24) hour a day emergency phone number, of local TGP representatives from our Hopkinton, MA facility that handle emergency response and our Northern Division office personnel located in Enfield, CT. It also includes information pertaining to our new compressor station in Burrillville, RI that we commissioned on October 16, 2002.



We look forward to speaking with you in detail about our emergency plans.


