In FY 07 Minuteman Senior Services provided services to 1,062 residents of Acton at a total value of \$445,564. A detailed breakdown of the services used is attached

As a nonprofit Aging Services Access Point our purpose is to (1) provide seniors with the assistance they need to live independently in their own homes and communities and (2) support family caregivers. The majority of our funding comes from government grants and contracts that have not kept pace with the growing senior population in our 16 community region.

We coordinate our work with Councils on Aging, community safety personnel and other local service providers. A resident of your community is a voting member of our Board of Directors to assure that your community's interests are represented in our program planning and decision making.

We are grateful for the continued support received from Acton. Your local assessment for FY 09 is \$2,896. It is based on the most recent federal census and adjusted annually by the CPI. These funds are critical as they enable us to leverage federal funds and help pay for our extensive Meals on Wheels program.
