## **Acton Sidewalk Committee**

### **Holds Second Public Meeting on April 15**

#### **Sidewalks on Selected Major Arteries to be Discussed**

Acton, MA (April 13, 2008 ) --- The Acton Sidewalk Committee will hold its second public input session on Tuesday, April 15, 2008 at 7:00 p.m. in Room 204 (Faulkner Room) in the Acton Town Hall at 472 Main Street in Acton Center to discuss possible sidewalk construction along selected major arteries.

Major arteries in Acton to be discussed are:

Route 2A ---- Great Road (Acorn Park to Littleton Town line)

Route 2A ---- Great Road (Town line to Concord Road)

Route 2A ---- Great Road (Concord Road to Brook Street)

Route 2A ---- Great Road (Brook Street to Main Street)

Route 2A ---- Great Road (Main Street to Acorn Park)

Route 27 ---- Main Street (2A to Ledge Rock Way)

Route 27 ---- Main Street (Ledge Rock Way to 935 Main Street)

Route 111 -- Massachusetts Ave. (Juniper Ridge to Guggins Brook)

Powder Mill Road (High St. to Maynard Town line)

“We encourage Acton residents to attend this public meeting to provide their comments on possible sidewalk construction along the town’s major arteries,” said Committee chairperson, Selectman Paulina Knibbe.

Knibbe noted that her committee has been working for several months in preparing sidewalk rating charts, and this public input will assist them in refining the criteria as they prepare to submit recommendations to town officials on where possible sidewalk construction should take place.

She said that a well-attended earlier public meeting was held on March 12, 2008 to discuss about a dozen selected collector streets, and valuable citizen input was provided.
