I would like your consent to dispose of 272 items that have been removed from Acton Memorial Library's collection. A list of the items is attached.

As of July 1, 2008, there were slightly over 146,000 items in Memorial Library's collection.

Most of the items have been withdrawn by professional librarians on staff due to poor condition, lack of accuracy or use, or because they are no-longer-needed multiple copies of a title which was once in high demand. A few have been lost or severely damaged and paid for by library users or identified as items which are no longer in the collection and need to be removed from the database to maintain its integrity.

Following your approval, they will be disposed of in the manner approved by the Board of Selectmen in February 2007.
