It is with great pleasure that I invite you to a Court of Honor being held for Matthew Eckler and Ryan Crumlish on Saturday, November 22, 2008, at 3:00 P.M. at the St. Elizabeth of Hungary Church, 89 Arlington Street in Acton, Massachusetts. Matthew and Ryan will be receiving the rank of Eagle Scout, the highest honor Boy Scouting offers.

Many of the skills Matt and Ryan gained on their trails to Eagle were put into practice while completing their Eagle projects. Ryan worked in conjunction with the Acton Conservation Commission to build boardwalks to protect portions of a trail along Guggans Brook, part of the conservation land in Acton. He enlisted the help of scouts and friends to build a total of 96 feet of wooden boardwalk, and installed them in sections where needed along the trail. Matt organized a food drive to benefit the Acton Food Pantry. Over 5 days of collection at three local grocery stores, Matt and fellow scouts collected approximately 45 boxes of food and over \$500 in cash donations. They then delivered and unloaded the food at the food pantry. The Town of Acton, Matthew's and Ryan's scout troop, their family and their friends are very proud of the fine work they accomplished.
