Arrange/attend regular meetings with business owners in Acton to gauge business climate, seek advice and input, and look for story ideas

Maintain regular interaction with local, state and federal government business agencies and associations .

Invite and host visiting business and government agency representatives to see and appreciate Acton as a good business location
