At 9:00 PM* Saturday evening, there is a Luminary Ceremony. White bags with a candle are placed around the pond path. Behind every bag there is a story to tell.

Each one is dedicated in honor of a cancer survivor or someone who has lost the fight with cancer. The candles surround the pond and light the way as Relay For Life participants walk throughout the night.
