### **PUBLIC HEARING ZONING AMENDMENT CREMATORY BAN CITIZEN'S PETITION**

The Town of Littleton Planning Board will hold a Public Hearing on Thursday, March 26, 2009 at 9:00 p.m. in Room 103 of the Shattuck Street Town Hall to consider amending the Zoning Bylaw, Chapter 173 of the Code of the Town of Littleton by adding "Article XXIV Crematory Facilities".

The proposed zoning amendment, by citizen petition:

#### "ARTICLE XXIV Crematory Facilities

§ 173-165 Purpose. The purpose of the bylaw is to prohibit the operation of a crematory to protect and promote the quality of the Town of Littleton's neighborhoods, commercial and business districts, and the general welfare, health and safety of the citizens of Littleton.

§ 173-165 Crematory Prohibition. No crematory shall be allowed in the Town of Littleton."
