Location: Nagog Hill Conservation Area, Acton

Description: Brian chose to build a 40-ft-long boardwalk over a swampy section of Acton's Nagog Hill conservation area. Hikers made a habit of scaling a dangerous, rocky wall to go around the swamp.
