RESPONSE TO QUESTION 6.

Plans were prepared pursuant to the original Orders of Condition referenced in paragraph 4. This request for Certificates of Compliance is being made to clear the record title and remove references to the expired Orders of Condition. New Orders of Condition were recently issued on April 21, 2010, DEP File No. 85-1039, to replace the expired Orders of Condition (the "New Orders of Condition").
