Yes, Phase III occurs after the Plan is adopted, including its action plan (which will include a mechanism for monitoring and updating). Phase III is the implementation of the approved Plan. What the Phase I summary is referring to on page 3 is the adoption of actual zoning amendments, which might be recommended in the Plan but are left to the implementation phase for drafting, hearing, and adoption.

Hi Margaret,

I'm confused about references to a Phase III in earlier documents, since none of our draft text mentions that. Looking at the graphic Sue recently sent, which may have been developed by Planners Collaborative during phase I, it looks like they were imagining Phase III was the Town meeting vote and beyond. But the graphic indicates that town meeting will be voting on the "goals and objectives" not the "prioritized strategies and objectives" and I thought the latter was an inherent part of the master plan that we hope to bring to Town meeting. Also, if you look at the summary page of the phase I report (<http://www.actonoutreach.com/pdfs/Acton%20Report%20at%20a%20glance.pdf>), that describes phase III as the compilation of ideas into an action plan (what I assume is the Master Plan) that will *then* be brought to Town meeting. The contract with Planners Collaborative is for Phase II but I thought it included the development of the plan that would be brought before Town Meeting. Celia
