Our goal is to provide affordable, quality dog training services and a range of other dog-related educational activities to the public. We will offer a wide range of classes in various areas of dog training, from basic pet obedience to performance sports as well as Therapy Dog Training. We will offer classes for the full spectrum of skill levels, from beginner to competition level training. All of our training will be based on positive reinforcement to ensure the best results and continued success. Our classes will be taught by experienced instructors with limited class sizes to make the most of the training experience. We will maintain an on-going relationship with our clients and give them the skills and tools they need for a happy and rewarding dog ownership experience.

We will offer one-hour training classes during the day and early evening where students and their dog(s) will come to train, then return home (much like what occurs at a veterinary clinic). No dogs would stay for extended periods of time in our building, no dogs would be kept overnight and we do not intent to offer any other activity like doggie day-care or grooming.

Julie Rembrandt Seeley, CPDT has been a professional dog trainer since 1988. She holds a Professional Membership in the APDT (Association of Pet Dog Trainers). She was among the group to take the first ever APDT Certification Exam for dog trainers in 2001, thus earning her the CPDT (Certified Pet Dog Trainer) title. Julie is an active Member of the Massachusetts Federation of Dog Club & Responsible Dog Owners and is also an AKC Rally Judge and one of the former owners of Four Paws Academy, Inc. in Boxborough, MA. This dog training business closed in December, 2010.

Julie and her husband breed and exhibit Miniature and Standard Poodles, under the kennel name Rembrandt, in conformation, obedience, rally, and agility. They have been breeding and exhibiting their own dogs since 1983 and have produced 43 breed champions, including several nationally ranked All-Breed and Specialty Best in Show winners and many obedience and agility titleholders.


