Hi Margaret-

Just a thought about resolving the remaining comments on the implementation tables. I've been revising based on the discussions the committee had on goals 2, 3, 4, 5, and 7. I've received Paulina's comments on all the goals, which are very thoughtful, but in many instances require someone to make a judgment call, and that should be the committee, not us. (See her comments on Goal 5 for an example, which I've attached.) I have been able to incorporate or revise comments when it's straightforward to do so, but in other instances it's the committee that should decide.

Given that this will take time for the committee to discuss each comment, and that more comments may be arriving from other members this week, Daphne and I would suggest the following.

We should collect a list of outstanding comments from the members, and where deliberation is needed, hold these and combine with the comments we receive at the Nov 9 meeting. (We think when in doubt, an action should remain in the tables for the public meeting.) After Nov 9 Daphne and I will prepare a master list of issues to resolve in the implementation tables, and the committee should try to address all of these at the meeting after the public meeting. (I'm out of town on Nov 16, so I'm hoping that meeting would be the week of Thanksgiving, maybe on Tuesday instead of Wednesday). That will give us time to get the final implementation program in shape for the BoS meeting on Monday Dec 5.

In any case, it would be good to resolve this process tomorrow night.
