

I did not get the message as I am not home yet, but here is my plan.

I would like to have music on Saturday nights. Music wouldn't begin until 7:30-8:00pm and would end by 10pm (approx.). It wouldn't be continuous during this time period. Each Saturday night would offer a different type of music. For example:

- 1st Saturday in month: Folk (Jackie Damsky & Seth Connelly)
- 2nd Saturday in month: Blues (1-2 guitarists with option for local residents to sit in)
- 3rd Saturday in month: Jazz or World Music
- 4th Saturday in month: Coffeehouse Night (local students, a cappella singers, guitarists, folksingers, or local resident who aren't professional musicians)

I would look to offer dinner specials combined with the music at a fixed price. For example, dinner+music for \$30.00/pp. For coffeehouse night, I was thinking of offering a Dessert and Coffee or Tea plus music for \$12/pp.

When I start brunch again (Mother's Day through the summer), I'd like to sometimes have music accompanying the meal which I know I do not need an entertainment license for. BUT, I would like the option to offer a Gospel brunch, which would bring a vocalist or two as well 2-3 musicians, and that would be more like an event than just music along with the brunch. I would schedule this for Sunday, say 12noon until 2pm.

During Oktoberfest this year, I'd like to have a couple of people playing outside the restaurant, likely on the grass across from my driveway, or, on the grass in front of the restaurant. I think German music would be fun, but actually, anything would be fun. I would do that after the Conant road race, probably 12-3pm.

I am NOT planning Karaoke night, open mike night or hosting any large, amplified bands.

Does this give you enough information?
