Town Counsel has good and valid point that should be considered.

A few clarifications:

1. The committee is proposed as an advisory committee to the Board of Selectmen; but it is also intended to work closely with the the Planning Board, the EDC and others to further the implementation of Acton 2020.
2. May 15 is indeed the correct date in the near future for the Planning Board adoption of the Master Plan pursuant to M.G.L. Ch. 41, S. 81D. This is the next scheduled meeting of the Planning Board. On that date the Planning Board will, as the statute suggests, consider adoption of the entire Acton 2020 Plan as the Town's Master Plan, not just the Goals and Objectives.
3. The proposed mission statement submitted for tonight's agenda is a draft intended for discussion purposes. We expect that members of the Board of Selectmen may desire changes in addition to those recommended by Town Counsel. The Board of Selectmen can then finalize and adopted the mission for the Implementation Committee shortly after the Planning Board has - hopefully - adopted the Plan on May 15.
