



In fulfillment of the requirements to complete the project, I respectfully submit my Compliance Report regarding the work performed at 20 Summer Street.

I have visually inspected the work at 20 Summer Street through construction starting June 17, 2010 and after completion on September 29, 2010 for compliance to 780 CMR and for work per the approved drawings at the public town hearing on June 16, 2010.

At the time of the inspection the site work was completed. During construction I witnessed the work that had been executed in a neat and workmanlike fashion by Nashoba Paving Co., Inc. per approved drawings.

The construction ended early October and all of the work was completed per the specification except the planting of the rain garden. The installation and soil preparation of the rain garden was completed correctly except for planting of the plant due to late completion of finishing work. The owner will plant the rain garden as specified in the late spring or as recommended for the species of plants.

In general the work was completed at a high quality and accuracy as well as all of the site issues were corrected




