- "Flood Insurance Study," Town of Acton, Massachusetts, Middlesex County, FEMA, Federal Insurance Administration, dated January 4, 1968.

These maps consist of an overlay of the "Flood Insurance Rate Map" drafted onto the Town Atlas, and are only to be considered an approximation for convenience. They should not be used to make a definitive determination as to how the Flood Plain affects a given property. For official determinations, please refer to the "Flood Insurance Rate Map" and the "Flood Insurance Study."


