





I Hiked Acton's Conservation Lands Program

How to participate

1. Download the "I hiked Acton's Trails Program Form" from Acton Recreation Dept. website link to be created, www.actontrails.org or pick one up at the Recreation Dept. at Town Hall, 472 Main St.
2. Before setting out on any hikes, learn about "Leave No Trace" at <http://lnt.org/learn/7-principles>



3. Read and abide by the Acton Conservation Land Regulations <http://actontrails.org/RegulationsRev.htm>
4. Hike the yellow main loop trail of each of the 16 listed conservation lands on the Participation Form. Be sure to download a map first, or take one from the map box on the kiosk at each parking area (marked K on maps). If you would like a Land Steward volunteer to guide your hike, please email lsc@acton-ma.gov.
5. When your form is complete: email it to lsc@acton-ma.gov or mail it to Acton Recreation Department, Acton Town Hall, 472 Main Street, Acton MA 01720. Include a self-addressed stamped envelope and we will mail you a sticker! Or you can bring your form to the Recreation Department at Acton Town Hall and get your sticker.
6. Always tell someone where you are going. Have fun and be safe!
