Dear Christine Joyce:

We want to thank you again for the excellent support that the Town of Acton provided for our Boston Brain Tumor Ride last year. And we hope that you will again approve our Ride in 2013. We value your participation in our event to ensure a successful and safe ride for our cyclists.

The date for our 2013 ride is Sunday, May 19th. We will have the same route as last year for both the 25-mile ride and the 50-mile ride. We will be starting from a new location this year, at 200 West Street, Waltham, MA. The 50-Mile riders will start at 8am and the 25-Mile riders will start at 9:00 am. We anticipate that all riders will return to the Finish area at 200 West Street, Waltham by noon. Last year there were approximately 225 riders in the two groups.

In Acton, we will again be using the same route that we used last year. We will proceed through these intersections: Strawberry Hill and Great Road, Great Road and Concord Road, Great Road and Pope Road

I am attaching a map of our 50-Mile Ride, which shows the route we will be passing through in Acton. We have received the Detail Request Form from the Lt. Prehl of the Police Department, which the Main office in Watertown will return, with a check for three officers for four hours to cover the above intersections.

We will also have full communication support from the Boston Area Amateur Radio Club. A ham radio operator will be in each support vehicle, as well as at Net Control at the event Start and Finish location. Contact person for the day of the event is Sammarye Lewis, 408-540-9077.
