Acton 2020 Presents Strategy for Kelley's Corner Revitalization

The Town of Acton adopted the Acton2020 Comprehensive Community Plan last year. One of the key strategies identified in the plan is to develop Kelley's Corner into a mixed use town center and transportation hub. On March 7th, the Acton 2020 Implementation Committee hosted a well-attended public forum in Town Hall to provide information on the \$277,000 funding request on the Town warrant - discussing how the funds will be used, what will be accomplished, and how Actonians can participate in the planning and design process. The Public Forum was the final in a series of meetings members of Acton 2020 have held or attended since January with Kelley's Corner neighbors and business owners, developers, and relevant Town Boards - the Board of Selectmen, Finance Committee, Economic Development Committee, and Design Review Board. The Town Manager has included this funding in his proposed town budget. The Board of Selectment approved this initiative in their final budget at their meeting on January 28th.

After passage of the 2020 plan by Town Meeting in the Spring of 2012, and subsequent approval by the Planning Board, the implementation phase has launched.
