I am concerned that too many houses are being squeezed into the Patriots Hill neighborhood. This is a well maintained mature neighborhood and it's character is marred by new developments in its midst notwithstanding the chaos, noise and dirt of actual construction. I was dismayed by the Jackson Drive extension development because of the loss of adjacent woodland and wildlife habitat, but at least it was on the edge of the neighborhood. This development is in the middle. Half acre lots are generally considered too small for septic systems and yet in Acton we continue to place new properties on this lot size. Many adjacent towns without sewage disposal have requirements of one-acre or greater. For a variety of reasons I oppose this new development in our community.
