



ORDER FOR CONDUIT LOCATION

In Board of Selectmen of the Town of **Acton** Massachusetts.

ORDERED:

That permission be and hereby is granted the NEW ENGLAND TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY to lay and maintain underground conduits and manholes, with the wires and cables to be placed therein, under the surface of the following public way or ways as requested in petition of said Company dated the **21st** day of **July** 19 **69**

Massachusetts Avenue (State Highway) - From proposed manhole 6 and continue easterly on and along the southerly side of the street for approximately 3,400 feet of conduit and 4 manholes.

Substantially as shown on plan marked—N. E. T. & T. CO., No. **216408** Dated **7-21-69**, filed with said petition.

Also that permission be and hereby is granted said NEW ENGLAND TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY to lay and maintain underground conduits, manholes, cables and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as it may desire for distributing purposes.

The foregoing permission is subject to the following conditions:—

1. The conduits and manholes shall be of such material and construction and all work done in such manner as to be satisfactory to the Board of Selectmen or to such officers as it may appoint to the supervision of the work, and a plan showing the location of conduits constructed shall be filed with the Town when the work is completed.
2. In every underground conduit constructed by said Company hereunder one duct not less than three inches in diameter shall be reserved and maintained free of charge for the use of the fire, police, telephone and telegraph signal wires belonging to the Town and used by it exclusively for municipal purposes.
3. Said Company shall file with the Town its agreement to indemnify and save the Town harmless against all damages, costs and expense whatsoever to which the Town may be subjected in consequence of the acts or neglect of said Company, its agents or servants, or in any manner arising from the rights and privileges granted it by the Town.
4. In addition to such agreement, said Company shall, before a public way is disturbed for the laying of its wires or conduits, execute its bond in a penal sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) (reference being had to the bond already on file with said Town) conditioned for the faithful performance of said agreement and of its duties under this permit.
5. Said Company shall comply with the requirements of existing by-laws and such as may hereafter be adopted governing the construction and maintenance of conduits and wires, so far as the same are not inconsistent with the laws of the Commonwealth.

I hereby certify that the foregoing order was adopted at a meeting of the Board of Selectmen of the Town of **Acton** Massachusetts, held on the **26th** day of **August** 19 **69**.

5. That the contractor contact the Acton Chief of Police regarding a suitable arrangement for traffic control in the area of construction.
6. That the underground installation of conduit presently under construction on Main Street, "Route 27" in Acton, as defined on Plan #PR112006, dated January 17, 1969, be completed to the satisfaction of the Acton Town Manager prior to initiation of construction under this petition.
