ORDER FOR BURIED CABLE LOCATION

By the Board of Selectmen
of the Town of **Acton**
ORDERED: **Massachusetts**

That permission be and hereby is granted the NEW ENGLAND TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY to place and maintain buried cable, manholes, handholes, and pedestals with the wires and cables therein, markers and other fixtures in or under the surface of the following public way or ways, as requested in petition of said Company dated the **5th** day of **March** 19 **70**

Main Street - Beginning at a point which is approximately 39 feet south of High Street and continuing on and along the westerly side of Main Street to the Acton-Maynard Town Line for approximately 4780 feet of Buried Cable.

Substantially as shown on plan marked—N. E. T. & T. CO. No.....**217878**
Dated.....**3-3-70**....., filed with said petition.

Also that permission be and hereby is granted said NEW ENGLAND TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY to place and maintain underground laterals, manholes, handholes, pedestals, cables and wires in the above or intersecting public ways for the purpose of making connections with such poles and buildings as it may desire for distributing purposes.

The foregoing permission is subject to the following conditions:

1. The laterals, manholes, handholes, pedestals, and markers shall be of such material and construction and all work done in such manner as to be satisfactory to such municipal officers as may be appointed to the supervision of the work, and a plan showing the location of buried cable laid shall be filed with the Town when the work is completed.
2. Said Company shall indemnify and save the Town harmless against all damages, costs and expense whatsoever to which the Town may be subjected in consequence of the acts or neglect of said Company, its agents or servants, or in any manner arising from the rights and privileges granted it by the Town.
3. In addition said Company shall before a public way is disturbed for the placing of its buried cable, execute its bond in a penal sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) (reference being had to the bond already on file with said Town) conditioned for the faithful performance of its duties under this permit.
4. Said Company shall comply with the requirements of existing by-laws and such as may hereafter be adopted governing the construction and maintenance of buried cable, conduits and wires so far as the same are not inconsistent with the laws of the Commonwealth.

CONDITIONS

1. A bond in the amount of \$10,000.00, or in the amount of \$1.00 per running foot, whichever amount is higher, for all approved contract work under this petition or any other petition that has not been terminated, shall be placed with the Town prior to any construction.
2. That all paved surfaces be replaced in their present locations with similar material as now exists.
3. That all work within five feet of any tree be done with the utmost of care and any excavation within five feet of any tree be done by hand labor.
4. That the contractor contact the Acton Police Chief regarding a suitable arrangement for traffic control and safe passage for pedestrians in the area of construction.
5. That at the completion of the construction New England Telephone & Telegraph Company contact the Acton Town Engineer relative to his inspection and approval of the completed project.
6. That construction shall not commence prior to June 15, 1970 and shall be completed no later than September 1, 1970.
7. That abutters whose driveways or sidewalks will be excavated during installation be notified by the contractor at least three days prior to excavation.
8. That no excavation in driveways or public ways be left open for more than twelve hours and that no other excavation be left open for more than seventy-two hours.
9. That the conduit be encased in concrete wherever it crosses the public way.


