TOPIC: Action Item Review

DISCUSSION	Nothing reviewed.
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TOPIC: GOWARD PLAYGROUND

DISCUSSION	Ms. Fochtman displayed an Engineering Department grading plan for the layout for the playground. Mr. Redmond who is volunteering his services, has been excavating and rebuilding the subsurface. There is a plan to channel runoff to a new drain. A two percent (2%) grade level must be maintained. The slopes will need to be determined from the lawn down to the playground. A Locust tree was causing problems with the slope. The Town Tree Warden, Mr. Dean Charter of Municipal Properties recommended that it be removed. Roots which were exposed and soil erosion were safety hazards that contributed to the decision to remove the tree. <i>Acton Item:</i> Ms. Fochtman will meet with Mr. Redmond and crew regarding the removal of any further tree.
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TOPIC: ELM STREET UPDATE

DISCUSSION	Ms. Fochtman reports she has met with the Gabrielli family. Acton Adult Softball has collaborated with Acton Recreation on signage at Elm Street with behavioral expectations that will be posted. Acton Adult Softball is requesting Sunday use of Elm Street and the Gabrielli's are requesting improved league behavior.
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TOPIC: NARA IMPROVEMENTS

DISCUSSION	Ms. Fochtman reported an upgrading of the bathhouse exterior which was cleaned and pressure washed prior to being stained. The bathrooms were upgraded with new stalls and toilets along with new faucet heaters. The amphitheater outside electrical cage has now been enclosed. Design funding for a NARA comfort station was also approved. The Miracle Field team members along with AASL also interested in the design of the station.
