CONDITIONS

1. That abutting residents be notified in writing, with a copy to the Town Manager, and in person 48 to 72 hours before work is commenced along their frontage on the public way.
2. That work begin no earlier than 9:00 A.M. and cease no later than 4:00 P.M. each work day.
3. That all trenches be filled at the close of the workday.
4. That no work be performed on Saturday, Sunday, or any State Holiday.
5. That driveways be open to the reasonable use of abutting residents.
6. That all work areas be restored to the reasonable satisfaction of abutting land owners.
7. All sidewalks, drives, roads and other areas shall be restored to their original condition.
8. Throughout construction the contractor shall coordinate his activities with the Town Engineer. The completion of construction shall be to the complete satisfaction of the Town Engineer who shall have an opportunity to make a complete inspection thereof.
9. That all work within five feet of any tree be done with the utmost care and any excavation within five feet of any trees be done by hand labor.
10. That all work be performed under the usual and accepted standards and practices applicable to New England Telephone and Telegraph Company underground conduit installation to assure the safety and convenience of abutters and users of the public way.
