

**Notification to Abutters Under the
Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act
and Acton Wetlands Protection Bylaw**

In accordance with the second paragraph of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 131, Section 40 and with the Acton Wetlands Protection Bylaw, you are hereby notified of the following.

- A. The name of the applicant is: Steve Marsh.
- B. The applicant has filed a Notice of Intent (NOI) with the Conservation Commission for the municipality of **Acton, MA** seeking permission to confirm the locations of Areas Subject to Protection under the Wetlands Protection Act (General Laws Chapter 131, Section 40) and the Dover Wetlands Protection Bylaw.
- C. The project scope is to: **Proposed construct of a single-family home, within the 200ft Riverfront.**
- D. The address of the lot where the activity is proposed is: **114 River Street.**
