





I am writing concerning the "permits to construct within a public way" numbers 83-45 and 83-105 issued to Exxon Co. USA in connection with the recent reconstruction of your service station at 289 Main St., Acton, MA.

In the interest of public safety and convenience Felix A. Marino Co., Inc., was hired by the Town to complete this work when Exxon Co. defaulted on their obligation under the terms of their permit.

Exxon was notified in writing on May 16, 1984 and again on August 17, 1984, to complete this work, but they did not respond.
