I have deposited the required bond with the Town of Acton, and I covenant and agree that the Town may deduct from this amount the cost of repairs to the road surface, curbs, shoulders, walls or other features within the right-of-way including replacing bounds if not completed by me to the satisfaction of the Town Engineer within the specified time.

1. The backfill shall be select material mechanically compacted in 6" lifts. The top 18" shall be processed roadway gravel as approved by the Town Engineer.
2. A temporary hot top patch shall be installed and maintained by the applicant immediately upon completion of backfill and until the permanent patch according to Section II-D-3 of the enclosed specifications is installed.
3. Schedule the water main tap with the Acton Water District 263-9107. Notify this department at 264-9628 twenty-four hours before starting work.



THE FOLLOWING WORK REMAINS TO BE DONE:

The patch in the street appears to be acceptable, however, the patch across the sidewalk is unsatisfactory. It seems to have settled due to trucks and equipment driving over it. To access the lot, we suggest that you only use the proposed driveway, repair the sidewalk patch, and allow that area to stabilize. A general cleanup of the area is also needed. This includes grading, loaming and seeding the grass strip and any other disturbed areas in the vicinity of the patch.

THE FOLLOWING WORK REMAINS TO BE DONE:

- 1.) The permanent patch placed on the trench area last fall has settled severely. Temporary repairs made since that time are unacceptable. Before the bond can be released the patch must either be repaired by infared equipment or excavated to a depth of 1 1/2" below street grade and replaced by conventional means. Joints shall be coated with asphalt sealer and sanded. The final patch must be stabile and smooth riding.
- 2.) Please notify this department 24 hours prior to the start of work so that inspections can be scheduled at appropriate times.
