Hello All,

The VCC has had significant interest lately from people who would like to serve on the EDC.

My understanding is that the EDC is not a statutory committee, however, the Committee Master List defines it to have 10 advisory members and 3 associate members. In addition, it defines the membership (as of 5/23/2000) to consist of:

- 2 Selectmen,
- 2 Planning Board,
- 1 Fincom,
- 2 Chamber, and
- 4 At-large members.

Currently it has:

- 0 Selectmen (although Franny is the Liaison),
- 1 Planning Board,
- 0 Fincom,
- 2 Chamber, and
- 4 At-large members.

That adds up to 7 members which means that there are openings for 3 (designated) members and 3 associate members.

So, here are the issues and questions we need answered:

Does the Board of Selectmen recognize the above described makeup of the EDC and is it their intent to maintain that makeup? If so, we, the VCC will try to direct interested volunteers to other committee openings. If not, then we need to know what the makeup of the EDC should be so that we can either encourage volunteers toward the EDC or to other committees as appropriate.
