We, the members of the Wright Hill Association LLC, are pleased to present the Community Preservation Committee with \$60,000 to be placed in the Community Preservation Committee gift fund.

We are holding an additional \$15,000 for our outstanding expenses and legal issues, and we plan to donate all that remains after these issues are resolved.

It was our desire to preserve the land, view, and access to the 18 Wright Terrace/Wright Hill property. We are thrilled that the Town saw Wright Hill's beauty, and human and natural history, and that the land will forever be a public jewel. This property was the last local home of the Mead family after the Wright and Mead families farmed in Acton and Boxborough for centuries.
