**TOPIC: DISCUSS COMMUNITY PRESERVATION COMMITTEE PRESENTATIONS**

<b>DISCUSSION</b>	<p>On Thursday January 15th, Ms. Fochtman will be presenting three recreation projects to the Community Preservation Committee (CPC). These three projects include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Phase #2 of the Skate Park Project – This is a plaza and park-like addition to the current skate park located on Hayward Road. The skate park was constructed ten years ago to honor a late Boxborough skater by the name of TJ O’Grady. Boxborough’s original plan was to help with the construction by giving \$40,000 toward the original plans, but was unfortunately voted down at their Town Meeting. Ms. Mitzi Weil, a Boxborough Recreation Commissioner, had presented the idea to the Boxborough Town Administrator on trying to help fund \$40,000 toward the second phase of the expansion project.</li> <li>2) Security Gate on the Inner Road at NARA Park – During the summer months, NARA Park has been having issues with vehicles driving on the inner road, which is really just for pedestrians to walk or for authorized vehicles only. There are signs up stating not to drive on this path; however the Recreation Department and summer staff feel that it isn’t enough to stop the public from driving through. It’s a hazard to have cars drive through this pedestrian walkway and the Recreation Department believes that a security gate will help with the safety of people walking the 1-mile path around NARA Park.</li> <li>3) Modular Bathrooms by the New Picnic Pavilion – Currently, the only non-portable bathrooms at NARA Park are located at the Bathhouse. After one season of having the New Picnic Pavilion open for rentals, the Recreation Staff has found that it is very inconvenient for the guests at functions to walk down to the bathroom, especially at night when there are limited light sources. Placing bathrooms close to the pavilion will definitely be more convenient and possibly appeal more to future renters. These bathrooms will only be open for functions and special events at NARA Park.</li> </ol>
