Green Advisory Board

The Green Advisory Board serves as an advisory committee reporting to the Board of Selectmen and **to** the local and regional *[is it just one regional school district now?]* school committees. **The GAB will help the Town and Schools realize more efficient use of natural resources through recommendations on municipal purchasing, planning, and operations decisions. Primarily, the GAB will help Acton reduce its carbon footprint by working with the Town and Schools to identify and prioritize energy-saving projects; the GAB will also help secure project funding through supporting Acton's participation in the Massachusetts Green Communities Act. Additionally, the GAB will advise the Town and Schools on other government functions, such as transportation planning, solid waste reduction and recycling, and water supply and sewage treatment.**

The Green Advisory Board has five full members and two associate members appointed by the Selectmen for three year terms.
