RE: Waiver of Fees for PMC- Kids (Pan Mass Challenge), Sunday June 5, 2016, 6:00AM-1:00PM

I recommend that the Board of Selectmen support Dana Greenberg's attached request for a waiver of fees, with the exception of out-of-pocket expenses, for a fundraising event at NARA to benefit PMC Kids, the Pan Mass Challenge, based at NARA's Miracle Field parking area. The rental fees that are to be waived are:

Walking Trail = \$350
2 Soccer Fields=\$240
Miracle Field = \$120
Softball Field = \$120
Total: \$830

This benefit walk has been organized to raise money for Dana Farber cancer research. Coordinator Dana Greenberg will agree to our requirements to operate this event:

- Post volunteers along Quarry Rd to direct participants to available parking areas and to avoid parking in NO PARKING areas on Quarry Rd.
- Have entertainment vendors, such as moonbounce vendors, provide a certificate of insurance liability with "Town of Acton" listed as an additional insured
- Order 2 standard portable toilets for the event
- Volunteers to chaperone participants and clean up all trash

We are excited about the use of NARA for this regional event. After three successful years, we're pleased to welcome PMC-Kids Acton Boxborough back to NARA.

Dear Selectman Janet Adachi:

You are probably familiar with the "Big" Pan Mass Challenge event that occurs in every year. Pan Mass Challenge events have an unwavering commitment to finding a cure for cancer. Since its start in 1980, the PMC has raised \$500 million for cancer research and cancer care. Although each individual rider has a personal reason for taking part in the event, they are strongly united in their cause...cure cancer. PMC Kids Rides became an official PMC program in 2005 as a way to include young cyclists in the Pan-Massachusetts Challenges' mission of raising money for cancer research and treatment at Dana-Farber Cancer Institute through its Jimmy Fund. The program engages youth in philanthropy, instills the value of working for the benefit of others, and promotes athletic fitness and physical activity.

In just 3 years, the Acton PMC Kids ride has raised over \$60,000 for cancer research. We have already set ourselves as an example for other kids rides around the state. Last year, we had over 180 kids attend our ride on a beautiful June day. Our town raised almost \$27,000 for cancer research! Pretty impressive for just kids riding bikes!

NARA park has proved to be an ideal location for such an event. We set up tents for registration and bike inspection (provided by Pedal Power) up in the parking lot and created a central area down on the softball field with games, music and a raffle tent. We created 2 bike courses, one for big kids (on 2-wheels) who road around the 1-mile bike path, and a second for newer riders; kids on training wheels and tricycles to ride around Miracle field. The Acton Fire Department came with one of their ladder trucks and hung a huge flag for kids to bike underneath.

Kids and parents all had a wonderful time that day. It was no surprise that we have done so well here in Acton and we are starting to plan for our 2016 kids ride. We hope to continue to grow our ride each year and surpass \$30,000 this year! We are planning our event on Sunday, June 5, 2016.

Use of these facilities costs money and we are reaching out to you to help relieve the costs of using NARA Park. We pledge that 100% of the money that the kids raise will go to Dana Farber. Covering costs of hosting the event will have to come from other sponsors, so we try to do our best to keep our costs as low as possible, so we don't take away from money we can donate to Dana-Farber/Jimmy Fund.



Picnic table availability is noted for each area. Additional tables are not provided by the Town of Acton.

You are welcome to bring your own charcoal or propane grill. All coals must be discarded in ash can. NARA Park bathrooms are open during normal beach operation hours. Portable toilets are onsite by the volleyball courts and upper parking lot.

CANCELLATION POLICY: If you cancel a facility/field reservation, you get a 50% refund; if less than 30 days notice, no refund will be issued. Group swim passes are not refundable. Refunds are not issued due to weather related conditions.

The Lessee or user of the facility/field will hold the Town of Acton and all its agents harmless from any problem resulting from the leasing or utilization of the premises. The Town of Acton reserves the right to cancel any permission, whenever, in its discretion, such cancellation seems advisable, and permits are subject to change.
