Dear Sir/Madam,

We are residents of Gabriel Lane, Acton and would like to bring your attention to the adjoining new office area on Great Rd, its parking lot and new 4 unit project – [267 Great Rd.](#)

The front portion of Gabriel Lane road is open and being shared and accessible from the aforementioned adjoining areas.

We are extremely concerned about the increased traffic in Gabriel Lane from these adjoining areas and its adverse impact on the safety of kids and residents in the community and close-by Gabriel Lane units. The Gabriel Lane is already not wide enough and this road patch would be highly prone to accidents.

Further, Gabriel Lane is a private road and we would like to keep Gabriel Lane road private and not share liability and maintenance with other adjoining neighbors and avoid any change to Gabriel Ln condo trust and related mortgage documents.

Hence, we all sincerely request you

- a. to block access to Gabriel Lane and not share it at all with the new Great Rd office area, its parking lot and new 4 house community and get it closed at the earliest and
- b. include all Gabriel Lane residents (cced) in all related discussions and decisions.
