
Dear Mr. Hulen:

On November 10, 2004, the Department of Environmental Protection conducted an inspection of your facility located at 916 Main Street in Acton, Massachusetts. Department personnel observed that activity occurred at the facility in noncompliance with the Massachusetts Hazardous Waste Management, Groundwater Discharge Permit, and Title 5 Subsurface Sewage Disposal Regulations, which are enforced by the Department.

As a result of the inspection, an Administrative Consent Order and Notice of Noncompliance, ACOP-CE-05-9013-2A, was executed by the Central Regional Office on March 18, 2005.

A follow-up inspection was conducted at your facility on July 13, 2005. It is the opinion of the Department that your company has complied with the requirements of the Administrative Consent Order and Notice of Noncompliance. The Department would like to thank you for your timely and appropriate actions.
