

WORKING HOURS (MONDAY - FRIDAY 09:00 A.M. TO 05:00 P.M.)



* Calls made directly to the Boston Office will be referred to the specific office.

** The LES will only be contacted, if deemed necessary, by the Regional or Division Director or their designee, and will give advice on the necessary chemical analysis to be taken and will also decide which analyses can be done by LES.

*** The Office of Incident Response will be contacted whenever there is a spill, release of oil and/or hazardous material. The Division of Water Supply will work with the Office of Incident Response until the end of situation. Each Division should exchange copies of all reports written as a result of the situation, e.g.: spill reports and water supply emergency data reports.



NON-WORKING HOURS (MONDAY - FRIDAY 05:00 P.M. TO 09:00 A.M.)

SATURDAY, SUNDAY & PUBLIC HOLIDAYS



* The DEP - Emergency Line can only be contacted through the State Police.

** The Regional Incident Response person may be able to handle the emergency without calling the Regional Director or his/her designee. Incident Response personnel are required to notify, by telephone, the regional water supply Section Chief at the start for within 24 hours of the event (emergency) being reported and forward a copy of the incident report to the Division of Water Supply at DEP Office in Boston.


*** The Regional Director or his/her designee will define the scope of the problem, determine who should handle the emergency response and who should be contacted, eg: contact the local Board of Health, etc. The Regional Director

his/her designee will also have available a list, with address/phone #s, of experienced volunteer water supply engineers. This list will also be available to the Office of Incident Response. This list should be prioritized in order of experience and their services will be reimbursed, for any time spent outside of their normal working hours, according to their current union contract.
