To All Boards and Committees,

At our June 20th meeting, the Acton Board of Selectmen voted to seek comment from all of the Town's boards and committees on the future use of the Morrison farmhouse and barn. The Town has completed a number of reports on Morrison Farm over the years and has weighed a variety of options for using, preserving, or dismantling both the house and the barn. The Selectmen are seeking your input as we hope to make a final decision, or recommendation to Town Meeting, on the future of these buildings. If your board or committee would like to make a recommendation on what to do with the farmhouse and/or the barn, please discuss at a future meeting and send any comments to Peter Berry, Chair of the Board of Selectmen, and Lisa Tomyl, Executive Assistant, prior to our **September 19th** meeting.

The Board of Selectmen will also be holding a public forum to solicit additional feedback from residents and will send more information when the date and time are confirmed. We plan to discuss these recommendations, the input from the public forum, the results of prior studies, and other information, and to take a vote on future action at one of our regularly

scheduled September meetings.

You are also welcome to send comments or speak at the public forum in your individual capacity as a citizen.
