Ideas entertained:

Move it and put it on a better accessible foundation elsewhere on property? To the east?

Caretaker? (If employee, there is question of inaccessibility for future employees, requires state approval)

Rented? (Costly to be landlord unless you have a bunch of like 20 houses)

Acton should look into other towns' process where they own a farm, eg Littleton and Lincoln.

Bathroom or other rail trail related use?

Storage for cemetery stuff? There is a little in the barn. Make barn stronger for cemetery purposes? Tom: we would certainly put stuff in it. However, Tom points out that once we own Harris most will be in there.

Recreation hall, space... ecorecreation... public gathering space?

Do Chelmsford, Westford, and Carlisle have amenities for the Bruce Freeman Rail trail?

If the building is taken down, Cemetery wants to be kept in the loop.
