Acton Indoor Sports L.P. has requested, by letter dated April 20, 2004, to withdraw their application to amend their existing Special Permit. Due to the change in the Zoning Bylaw at the April Town Meeting the applicant is no longer able to amend their existing permit. I would recommend the Board allow the application to be withdrawn.

In the same letter the applicant has requested both the Common Victualler's license and Liquor license request be continued. The applicant has since filed for a new Special Permit for a restaurant, which has tentatively been scheduled for June 14, 2004 at 7:15 p.m. I would recommend both the Common Victualler's license and Liquor license application be continued until June 14th at 7:20 p.m.


Special Permit Application
