


Subj: Makaha Restaurant





ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME WHILE ON PATROL I WAS TRAVELING NORTH ON MAIN ST IN THE AREA OF KELLY RD. I OBSERVED A VEHICLE DISPLAYING MA REG 6334XG TRAVELING IN FRONT OF ME. THE OPERATOR OF THE VEHICLE WOULD HIT HER BRAKES AND PULL TO THE RIGHT AS ANOTHER VEHICLE PASSED HER TRAVELING SOUTH ON MAIN ST. WHEN THE VEHICLE REACHED THE INTERSECTION OF MAIN ST AND MASS AVE THE VEHICLE WAS IN THE LANE TO TRAVEL STRAIT ON MAIN ST. THE OPERATOR THEN JERKED THE VEHICLE INTO THE LEFT TURN LANE AND TRAVELED WEST ON MASS AVE. I FOLLOWED THE VEHICLE WEST ONTO MASS AVE. AS I FOLLOWED THE VEHICLE I CLOCKED THE OPERATOR FOR A HALF MILE IN THE AREA OF PROSPECT ST TRAVELING AT A SPEED OF 55 MPH IN A 30 MPH ZONE. THE VEHICLE WOULD WEAVE TOWARDS THE EDGE OF THE ROAD. THE OPERATOR WOULD JERK THE VEHICLE BACK TOWARDS THE CENTER OF THE ROAD CROSSING OVER THE CENTER LINE AND THEN DRIFTING BACK TOWARDS THE EDGE OF THE ROAD. AT THIS POINT I ACTIVATED MY BLUE LIGHTS TO STOP THE VEHICLE IN THE AREA OF DEACON HUNT RD. THE VEHICLE CONTINUED TRAVELING WEST ON MASS AVE AT 55 MPH WEAVING, CROSSING OVER THE CENTER LINE AND TRAVELING AT THE EDGE OF THE ROAD. THE OPERATOR CAME TO A STOP ON MASS AVE AT SPRUCE ST.

I APPROACHED THE OPERATOR OF THE VEHICLE AND REQUESTED FOR HER LICENSE AND REGISTRATION. I EXPLAINED TO THE OPERATOR NOW IDENTIFIED AS DIANE W HOUDE, THE REASON WHY I STOPPED HER. AT THIS POINT I COULD DETECT AN ODOR OF AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE COMING FROM INSIDE THE VEHICLE. I ASKED MS HOUDE IF SHE HAD BEEN DRINKING TONIGHT, SHE STATED WITH A SLURRED SPEECH, "NO, I AM ON MEDICATION THAT IS WHY MY EYES ARE LIKE THIS". I THEN ASKED MS HOUDE WERE SHE WAS COMING FROM, SHE STATED "A FRIENDS HOUSE ON GREAT RD". I THEN ASKED HER WHY SHE WAS TRAVELING TOWARDS GREAT RD WHEN SHE WAS JUST COMING FROM THERE, SHE STATED "I AM DRIVING HOME TO BERLIN". I THEN ASKED MS HOUDE IF SHE WOULD CONSENT TO SOME FIELD TESTS, AND SHE COMPLIED.

I REQUESTED FOR MS HOUDE TO STATE THE ALPHABET FROM THE LETTER "C" TO THE LETTER "W". MS HOUDE SLURRED THE LETTERS AND HER SPEECH WAS SLOW. MS HOUDE STATED THE LETTERS UP TO "Y" AND THEN STATED "OH YOU WANTED ME TO STOP AT W". I THEN REQUESTED FOR MS HOUDE TO STEP FROM THE VEHICLE. WHEN SHE STEPPED FROM THE VEHICLE SHE WAS UNSTEADY ON HER FEET, AND HAD TO HOLD THE SIDE OF HER VEHICLE TO MAINTAIN HER BALANCE. I EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED TO MS HOUDE THE NINE STEP FIELD TEST. DURING THE INSTRUCTION PHASE OF THE FIELD TEST MS HOUDE STOOD WITH HER RIGHT FOOT SIDWAYS WITH HER LEFT FOOT IN FRONT OF HER. I REQUESTED FOR MS HOUDE TO CORRECT HER FEET. WHEN MS HOUDE ATTEMPTED TO CORRECT HER FEET SHE LOST HER BALANCE AND STEPPED OF THE ROAD. MS HOUDE THEN PLACED HER FEET IN THE SAME POSITION. AGAIN I REQUESTED FOR HER TO CORRECT HER FEET. MS HOOD BEGAN TO YELL AT ME STATING "I CAN'T DO THIS STOP CRITICIZING ME I DID NOT DO ANYTHING WRONG". MS HOUDE THEN STATED "OK I WILL DO THIS". MS HOUDE PLACED HER FEET BACK IN THE SAME POSITION. WHILE MS HOUDE PERFORMED THE FIELD TEST SHE DID NOT TOUCH HEAL TO TOE ON ANY OF THE STEPS. MS HOUDE WOULD TAKE A STEP AND THEN INCH THE FOOT THAT WAS IN THE BACK FORWARD AND THEN TAKE ANOTHER STEP. SHE WALK 15 STEPS OUT NOT COUNTING OUT LOUD. WHILE TAKING THESE 15 STEPS SHE RAISED HER ARMS TO MAINTAIN HER BALANCE AT SHOULDER LEVEL. I REQUESTED FOR MS HOUDE TO PLACE HER ARMS DOWN BY HER SIDE THREE TIMES AND SHE DID NOT. ON THE RETURN STEPS SHE WALKED 12 STEPS BACK IN THE SAME MANNER. MS HOUDE WOULD HAVE CONTINUED WALKING MORE THAN 12 STEPS IF I HAD NOT TOLD HER TO DISCONTINUE THIS FILED TEST. I THEN EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED THE ONE-LEG-STAND FIELD TEST. AS I WAS EXPLAINING THE FIELD TEST MS HOUDE STATED "I CAN'T DO THIS I HAVE BACK PROBLEMS". I DISCONTINUED THIS FIELD TEST. I THEN GAVE MS HOUDE THE NYSTAGMUS FIELD TEST. MS HOUDE EYES DID NOT MOVE WITH SMOOTHNESS AND HER EYES JERKED PRIOR TO MAXIMUM DEVIATION AND AT MAXIMUM DEVIATION.

IT WAS AT THIS POINT I FORMED THE OPINION MS HOUDE WAS INTOXICATED AND PLACED HER UNDER ARREST. OFFICER ABRAMOWITZ INVENTORIED THE VEHICLE WHILE I TRANSPORTED MS HOUDE BACK TO THE STATION. DURING THE TRANSPORT BACK TO THE STATION I COULD DETECT A STRONG ODOR OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE COMING FROM THE REAR OF MY CRUISER WHERE MS HOUDE WAS LOCATED. UPON MY ARRIVAL AT THE STATION MS HOUDE BEGAN TO CRY. MS HOUDE STOOD IN THE CORNER OF THE BOOKING CAGE WITH HER FACE TOWARDS THE WALL. SGT COGAN ATTEMPTED TO GO THROUGH THE BOOKING PROCESS. WHILE SGT COGAN WAS GIVING MS HOUDE HER RIGHTS SHE COLLAPSED ONTO THE FLOOR CRYING. I WAS THEN INFORMED FROM SGT COGAN MS HOUDE [REDACTED] AND WAS REQUESTING FOR [REDACTED]. SGT COGAN CALLED FOR AN AMBULANCE AND SHE WAS TRANSPORTED TO EMERSON HOSPITAL. UPON MY ARRIVAL AT EMERSON

HOSPITAL THE STAFF HAD DIFFICULTY EVALUATING MS HOUDE. MS HOUDE BECAME COMBATIVE AT ONE POINT TOWARDS THE STAFF.

MS HOUDE STATED "I AM NOT A CRIMINAL FOR SELF MEDICATING MYSELF WITH ALCOHOL TO HELP MY PAIN". APROXITMATLY 15 MINUTES AFTER BEING AT THE HOSPITAL MS HOUDE BEGAN TO VOMIT. AFTER MS HOUDE VOMITED SHE STATED MEN SUCK I WANT THEM OUT OF THE ROOM. I WAS THEN INFORMED BY THE STAFF AT EMERSON HOSPITAL THEY WERE UNABLE TO DO AN EVALUATION OF MS HOUDE UNTIL SHE SOBERED UP.

AT 0800 HOURS MS HOUDE WAS RELEASED FROM EMERSON HOSPITAL. I TRANSPORTED HER BACK TO THE STATION WHERE DET COWAN COMPLETED THE BOOKING PROCEDURE.

MS HOUDE WAS CONSIDERED A REFUSAL OF THE BAC. I SEIZED MS HOUDE'S DRIVERS LICENSE AND SHE WAS GIVEN A TEMPORARY LICENSE. I WROTE MS HOUDE A CITATION (K4188051) FOR THE FOLLOWING:

- 90-24 OUI ALCOHOL
- 89-4A MARKED LANES VIOLATION
- 90-17 SPEEDING
