Newspapers and inserts Corrugated cardboard Chipboard cereal boxes, shoe boxes, etc. Junk mail and glossy papers Phonebooks Magazines and catalogues Hard and soft-cover books	Place loose paper into the bin Flatten boxes	No soiled paper No plastic No plastic bags No Styrofoam
Glass Bottle, Can and Plastic Container Bin	How To Prepare	Do Not Include
Clear, green and brown bottles and jars	Remove lids and neckrings Rinse clean Labels may be left on May flatten	No window glass No dishes, No Pyrex No ceramic, No light bulbs No fluorescent light bulbs or mirrors
Deposit and non-deposit cans Metal food cans Aluminum foil	Rinse clean May flatten Labels may be left on	No paint or aerosol cans No other metal items No coat hangers No pots and pans No extension cords
All plastic containers labeled  through 	Remove lids and neckrings Rinse clean Crush when possible	No plastic bags No motor oil containers No unmarked containers No plastic plant pots

Grass, leaves, plants Woodchips, twigs and all easily raked materials Christmas trees	Bring loose Remove tinsle from Christmas trees	No plastic bags No stumps
Ash Disposal Area	How To Prepare	Do Not Include
Ashes	Dump loose	No plastic bags
Waste Oil Area	How To Prepare	Do Not Include
Used motor oil only		No solvents No gasoline
Scrap Metal Pile	Prior to disposing of any metal appliance, check with the attendant for location and possible fees.	
White Goods Area	Prior to disposing of any metal appliance, check with the attendant for location and possible fees.	
Donations area	Returnable bottles and cans (rinsed clean and with the caps removed) can be donated to support the Acton Community Supper. Clothing can be donated to the Salvation Army.
